

Level 3 Police Pathway Programme

The New Zealand Police have developed an innovative and creative initiative to support the transition of Year 13 students into a career in New Zealand Police.

This programme aims to provide students with a foundational understanding of real-world knowledge, constructive attributes and positive attitudes associated with Policing in Aotearoa. In addition, the course gives students opportunity to explore physical and leadership requirements of being a police officer.

Topics include

- » The role of Police in contributing to better public services and societal outcomes
- » History of police within the community
- » Diversity of policing in the community
- » Mātauranga Maori and police
- » Communication
- » Formal and informal interview strategies
- » Physical appraisal training and testing
- » Psychometric testing
- » Leadership in Police
- » Emotional Intelligence and policing
- » Community work- based experiences

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How the course works?

Specific sessions will assist students to have an understanding of theory and practical elements of topics in the course. Teaching sessions will include;

- » Classroom based sessions
- » Guest presentations
- » Online based activities
- » Practical experiences
- » Visits to local Police Stations and operational groups
